Wigan Council have confirmed the following:

- (a) The amount of Council Tax Support Grant for 2019/20 will be £8,813 – the same as in 2018/19. This will be reviewed for 2020/21. There is, as always, a strong possibility of the grant either being reduced or withdrawn from the parish councils from 2020/21.
- (b) The Council Tax Base for 2019/20 has increased to 3336 from 3315 in 2018/19. Consequently, maintaining the precept at the same level as in 2018/19 (£69,449) would result in a small reduction for each household, i.e. residents of a Band D property would pay £20.82 per annum (0.62% less).

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- (c) Because of the increase in tax base, maintaining the same charges per household as in 2018/19 would result in a 0.63% increase in income for the Council (£440). In other words, the precept would become £69,889.

Looking into the future, with either no further Council Tax Support grant or a reduced grant on the horizon and a loan to repay, members may wish to consider a further small increase in precept. The figures in the table demonstrate the impact that an increase of £551 (which equates to approximately 0.79% on £69,449 and 0.14% approximately per property) would have on each household.
