Thomas	Gladman	176 Standish Lower Ground, also on Standish WM
John	Grundy	17 Woodcock Row, Crooke
William	Halton	Lower House, Dalton (1911). Parents had moved to Shevington Vale by 1918.
John James	Hill	31 Moorfield Houses, Crooke
Frederick	Hodge	Shevington Vale (1911), but wife lived at Hunter's Hill, Wrightington, when she received the news (1917), also on Appley Bridge WM (as Hodges).
William	Holland	33 Gathurst Lane
Richard	Hooton	2 Whitehill Cottages, Shevington, also on St Marie's WM
Thomas	Jackson	10 Shevington Lane
Harry	Kitchen	87 Crooke
John	Marshall	75 Crooke
Edward	Stopforth	79 Gathurst Lane
Harry Randolph	Taylor	"Wellsdale", Gathurst Lane, not known to Wigan archives.
Oswald	Wilson	21 Almond Brook Road, or 60 Shevington Moor, also on St Marie's WM.

Should these be included? (* = I would suggest)

Harry	Barton*	Lived in Dalton, sister in Crow Lane, Appley Bridge, died on the "Royal Edward", sunk on 13/08/15 on way to Gallipoli, no known grave, not on any memorial.
Herbert	Cheshire*	(10?) Church Lane, Shevington, d.o.d. 5/5/16, left a widow and four children, buried in France, not on any memorial.
Thomas	Gaskell	69 Standish Lower Ground, d.o.d. 15/2/17 in Mesopotamia, buried in Iraq, also on Wigan and Standish WMs.
James	Glover	Address in Canada from where he joined up but from a 144 Standish Lower Ground family; d.o.d. 29/11/15, buried in France, not on any memorial.
Frank Smith	Marrow	John Pit Cottage, Standish (wife), 34 Standish Lower Road (parents), d.o.d. 11/10/16, student at Oxford, buried in France, also on Standish WM.
William	Porter	95 Standish Lower Ground, drawer at John Pit, "born in Shevington", d.o.d. 25/09/1915, no known grave, also on Standish WM.
Edwin	Stokes	46 Standish Lower Ground, d.o.d. 30/11/16, drawer at Taylor Pit, buried in France, also on Standish WM.

The last five are included because some years ago the PC included Thomas Gladman.
