 - The payment for the replacement bench was made in June. As we do not have a named cost centre for 'Benches', either one has to be set up and £620 in funds need to be vired from another cost centre to cover the

expenditure or a suitable cost centre needs to be suitably re-named. We have unused funds in the 'Doggie Bins/Notice Boards' cost centre. As this name is restrictive, members are invited to consider re-naming it as 'Street/Site Furniture & Notice Boards'. In that way the expenditure can be recorded under this heading.
