- 4. Quarterly Budget Monitoring for review (enclosed)
 - Most cost centres are on line. The 'Allotments' and 'Tree Survey/works' cost Centres are showing small overspends. Virements will be needed to offset these. The 'Street Furniture' cost centre appears to be showing a large overspend, but the balance will revert to a positive one once the Council has received the promised donation for the bench.

 This cost centre is funded from allotment income, which this year has come to £1,356.
 - Only £1,100 was set aside for budgeted expenditure. The balance of £256 went into the General Reserve and may now be used in this virement.
- b) £65 from the 'Expenditure Contingency' cost centre to the 'Tree Survey/works'
