Dist Cllr M Whittham's report covered the following:

Saturday Morning Surgeries

Now that Shevington Library had re-opened, the district councillors' regular Saturday morning surgeries would resume again.

'Ring & Ride' Service

Representatives of the 'Ring & Ride' service had visited the library earlier in the day to promote the service. There had been a number of good conversations. Amongst them had been the suggestion that information about the service should be included in the Parish Council's newsletter.

Planting of Bulbs

This project was in hand and the bulbs would be planted in the near future.

Preview of the New Bus Station

Dist Cllr Whittham had attended a preview of the new bus station, which was soon to be open to the public.
